Dear Professor Taylor,

I am again writing to you concerning your proposal entitled "Using novel technology to improve the measurement and evaluation of 24-hour movement patterns: the 'TIME-2-MOVE' study", Ethics Committee reference number H18/073.

Thank you to Anna Graham-DeMello for her email of 18th February 2019 with request for amendment attached relating to the above study.

We note that the research team would like to change the type of wearable camera the participants use to measure physical activity in their free-living environment from a 'Narrative 2' to a Go Pro. In the amendment it is noted that the Narrative 2 is unable to provide the data required. We further note, as a result of the change in device that the amount of time participants will wear the camera has been reduced to up to 8 hours (from 30 hours) and that the overall length of the study is now expected to be 2 days rather than 3.

Thank you for the detailed consideration given to the potential ethical issues. The Committee accepts and approves the amendments.

Thank you for the revised documentation, the Committee's records have been updated accordingly.

Your proposal continues to be fully approved by the Human Ethics Committee. If the nature, consent, location, procedures or personnel of your approved application change, please advise me in writing. I hope all goes well for you with your upcoming research.
