Thank you for submitting the above study for single ethical review. This project was considered to be eligible to be reviewed as Low and Negligible risk research, and so was reviewed at an Executive Meeting of the Hunter New England Human Research Ethics Committee on 11 April 2018. This Human Research Ethics Committee is constituted and operates in accordance with the National Health and Medical Research Council's *National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research (2007)* (National Statement) and the *CPMP/ICH Note for Guidance on Good Clinical Practice*. Further, this Committee has been accredited by the NSW Department of Health as a lead HREC under the model for single ethical and scientific review.
