- **Approval is granted** for a waiver of consent pursuant to s.95 of the *Privacy Act 1988*.

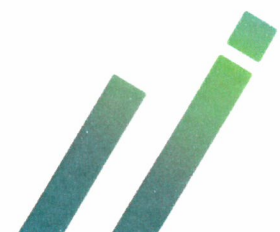
