

Does the COVID-19 vaccine affect menstrual bleeding and pain?



Recent reports suggest temporary changes in menstrual patterns following COVID-19 vaccination.

- Have had at least one menstrual period in your life
- Are NOT menopausal OR have NOT had a hysterectomy (removal of uterus/womb)
- Are NOT pregnant or breastfeeding or planning on pregnancy in the next 12 months
- Are currently having menstrual periods OR are currently not having periods due to use of hormonal contraceptives or other hormones for eg. period control or gender affirmation
- Have just had your 1st COVID-19 vaccine today or are booked to have it soon
- Are aged 18-45 years
